WOODWARD COMMUNITY FOOD PANTRY

The Woodward Community Food Pantry will now be open 4 times a month starting in January 2026 to better support the communities of Woodward, Granger and Bouton. We will be open 2 Saturdays and 2 Wednesdays a month. The Saturday's will remain the second and fourth of the month with the hours of 2pm-4pm. The Wednesday's will be scheduled throughout the month and hours will be 5pm-7pm. Residents may access the full pantry twice a month and may access the pantry for rescue food on all four dates scheduled for the month. **March 4th and 18th 5PM - 7PM**
