WOODWARD GOLF AND RECREATION

Located in Des Moines Township,
southwest of the town of Woodward, is
the Woodward Golf and Recreation area,
consisting of a club house, golf course,

swimming pool, bath house, and two golf
cart storage rental sheds.

This recreation area became possible
due to the enthusiasm and hard work of
many of the local citizens. During the
winter of 1966-1967, the ground work was
laid and plans began to form for the
recreation area. One of the first priorities
was to find a location and acquire the
needed land. This was purchased from Mr.
and Mrs. Robert Elliott and the original
Articles of Incorporation were filed on
April 13, 1967. The men responsible for
starting this project were: Donald R.
(Barney) Wall, William M. Siglin, Lloyd
Whitney, Russell Boyles, Robert Boyles,
Neil Prueitt, Howard Schutt, and Lee
Battani.

It was necessary to obtain a loan and
Arden Newell gave the group much help
instructing and assisting them in meeting
the regulations necessary in order to
obtain the needed F.H.A. loan.
Approximately two hundred shares of
stock were also sold to members of the
community. Many other persons joined
the above group in order to complete the
project and on July 1, 1968, the area was
officially opened.

Serving on the first board of directors
were: Dale Feazell, Robert Boyles, Howard
Schutt, Russell Bice and Lee Battani. The
first board of officers were: President,
Russell Boyles; vice president, Kenneth
Seemann; secretary, Robert Sturgeon;
and treasurer, Neil Prueitt.

TODAY, the golf course, now known as the
Woodward Golf Club, brings many people
from the surrounding areas to Woodward.
