

GREEN CLOTHES BIN / ANCESTRY.COM


How is the Green Clothes Bin connected to Ancestry.com? Well, if you have donated items to the bin, you have helped the library to subscribe to the ancestry website. The library receives a check each month based on the weight and the quality of the items in the bin. The check is usually between\$20 to \$60 each month. Those checks are saved until the library has the amount needed for a project. The first project for which those dollars are being used is Ancestry.com. Patrons are now able to do their genealogy search at the library for free. Ancestry.com is now available on any library computer! You can even bring your own device into the library and log on to the ancestry program.
